

Education Coordinator

The Virginia Department of Education Region 5 Training and Technical Assistance Center is seeking a qualified and experienced education professional to provide training and consultation to personnel who serve students with disabilities in west-central Virginia. We are looking for a dynamic candidate who is interested in a work environment that affords ongoing personal learning opportunities, collaboration with colleagues, and an opportunity to influence inclusive educational practices.

T/TAC coordinators respond to requests for training and technical assistance from public schools and state operated programs; coordinate and deliver professional development training; disseminate information and resources to facilitate programming; write consultation reports and newsletter articles; collaborate with agencies; and coordinate services with the Virginia Department of Education initiatives, including providing assistance to schools that are accredited with warning. Requires extensive travel in Superintendents' Region 5, which includes 20 public school divisions; some statewide and overnight travel is necessary.

Candidates must minimally hold a bachelor's degree with licensure and endorsement in special education. A master's degree and/or BCBA certification is preferred. Demonstration of knowledge, skills, and experience in the following areas is highly desired:

- Effective collaboration with colleagues, families, administrators, and other stakeholders
- Implementation of inclusive practices to facilitate access to the general education curriculum for students with autism spectrum disorders
- Implementation of research-based instructional and behavioral practices
- Effective communication in both written and oral formats
- Presentation of effective professional development
- Efficient management of professional time, independently and as a team member
- Proficient level of skill with Windows-based programs
